

Rancho CASI de los Chisos Old 320 Membership Rights and Privileges

Governance of the Old 320

The operations and management of Rancho CASI de los Chisos rest with the CASI Board of Directors. The Alcalde is the liaison from the Old 320 Members to the CASI Board; the Alcalde is not a voting Board member. Old 320 Members make recommendations to the Board through the Alcalde.

The Alcalde is elected to a two-year term, with no term limit.

The Alcalde maintains the official records of the Old 320, including the record of ownership and Old 320 Member bequeath requests, if any. The Alcalde maintains the official list of individuals wishing to purchase Old 320 memberships.

In the event an Old 320 site is not designated to be used by an Old 320 Member for any TICC, the Alcalde may assign a cook to that site.

Privileges of Membership

Each Old 320 Member receives an annual invitation to the CASI Terlingua International Chili Championship. Included as part of this invitation are entry into the contestants' camping area and waived gate fee for the Old 320 Member and significant other, who will receive one (1) wrist band each only if they are not qualified to cook or to show

Old 320 Members have the privilege of cooking on their Old 320 sites each year they are qualified for the CASI TICC. Guests of qualified Old 320 Members may cook with Old 320 Members on their sites. In years Old 320 Members do not qualify to cook, they may designate other qualified cooks to use their sites. For Old 320 sites held by CASI-affiliated Pods, it is the responsibility of the Great Pepper of those Pods owning sites either to provide written notice to the Alcalde of the qualified cook(s) who will use the site or advise of site availability.

An annual meeting of Old 320 Members is held at the annual TICC. The purpose of this meeting is to share concerns and suggestions and, in alternate years, elect an Alcalde. Proxy voting for this meeting is not permitted.

Old 320 Members have the duty to keep their address and contact information

current with the Alcalde. Transfer of Old 320 Sites

In the event the Alcalde is unable to locate an Old 320 Member after notification of Registered Mail for three (3) years, then the Old 320 Site(s) reverts to CASI.

Old 320 Members may cede their sites to CASI at any time. Old 320 Members who give up their site(s) retain the privileges of parking in the contestants' area and waived gate fee to the Rancho CASI de los Chisos but do not retain voting privileges.

All subsequent owners are entitled to full privileges of Old 320 Membership.

When an Old 320 site is voluntarily given back to CASI, the person or entity at the top of the waiting list maintained by the Alcalde will be offered the site.

Upon the death of an Old 320 Member, the site may be bequeathed to a person of the Old 320 Member's choosing. Intent to bequeath a site may be recorded with the Alcalde or, the Old 320 Member's family may make a designation. Old 320 sites may be transferred once using this mechanism. Upon the death of the person receiving a bequeathed Old 320 site, the site will revert to the Old 320 waiting list.

An Old 320 site held in a Pod's name will revert back to CASI one year from the date that the Pod ceases to be a CASI affiliated Pod.
