

Rules of Rancho CASI de los Chisos

The term “vehicle” when used in this document includes any motor driven vehicle, ATVs, golf carts, motorcycles, motor scooters, etc.

- > Propane stoves, grills, and BBQ pits will be permitted for cooking. Please exercise caution.
- > Fires must be contained in a fire pit, fire ring or other enclosure. There are to be no unconfined fires on the ground. Additionally, the perimeter of the fire pit or ring should be cleared of all vegetation.
- > Fires cannot be any larger than 3 foot tall. Meaning **NO LARGE FIRES!**
- > No accelerants will be used on fires, ie, gas, lighter fluid, etc. Additionally, no volatile items may be thrown into the fire.
- > Fires must be attended at all times.
- > No furniture, cars, tires or non-earth grown items will be allowed on site for burning.
- > It is requested that all persons entering the ranch have a working **FIRE EXTINGUISHER** in their possession.
- > All fireworks and explosives are **PROHIBITED!**
- > Please be aware that any participant violating the fire safety guidelines will be asked to leave the TICC site immediately with no refund in entrance fees.
- > All vehicles must travel on marked roads (not trails) only. Travel on any trails is strictly prohibited.
- > Anyone found traveling on trails, blocked trails or blocked roads is subject to confiscation of their vehicle for the remainder of the event and/or eviction of the operator/owner of the vehicle from the property. No refund in entrance fees will be provided.
- > Travel speed at all times shall not exceed five (5) mph.
- > Please, no foot traffic on trails after dark.
- > Camping in creek beds is **strictly prohibited**; water can rise rapidly & with no warning.
- > Please dispose of litter in the containers provided. If you bring large items on site with you, it will be noted when you enter the grounds. You **must remove** them when you leave. This is not a landfill site!
- > Pets **must** be under the owner’s control at all times. It is recommended that pets not be in the Old 320 (cooking) area on Saturday.
- > If you need to drive on the highway, please remember: **DON’T DRINK and DRIVE!**

NOTE: These rules are subject to change by the local jurisdiction and or the CASI Board of Directors if or when the current weather conditions change.
